Exit the Greenway when you see the Ivy-covered building at 27th Avenue in Seward. The beer garden is near the corner of 27th Avenue and 26th Street in the parking lot.

MoZaic Art Park behind the Lagoon Theater in Uptown

Take the Girard Avenue ramp in the Greenway, just east of Hennepin Avenue. MoZaic Art Park plaza is located across the pedestrian ramp. Chef Lucas Pizza will be making personal pizzas, including a special version made just for the Glow!

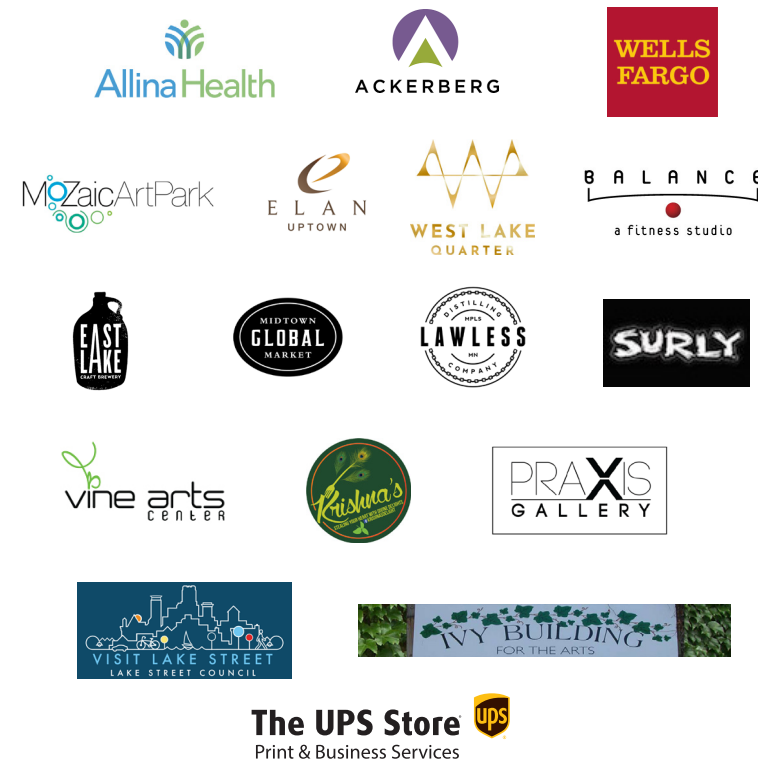
Restroom and Hand Washing Stations

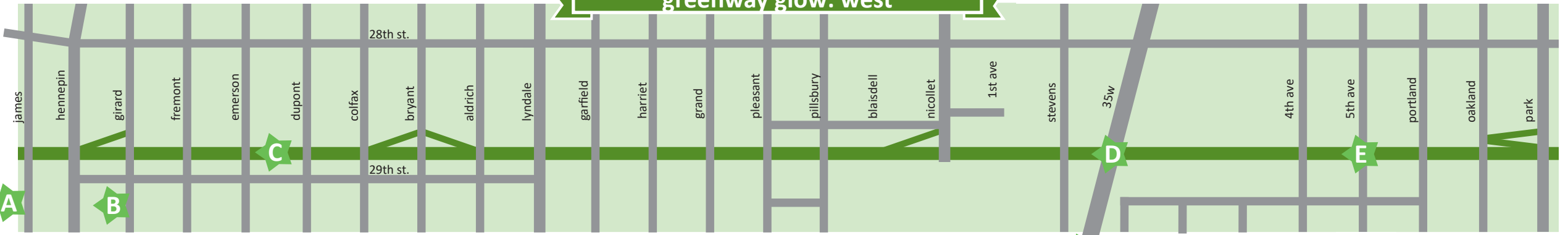
A porta-potty will be located near 11th Avenue on the Greenway.

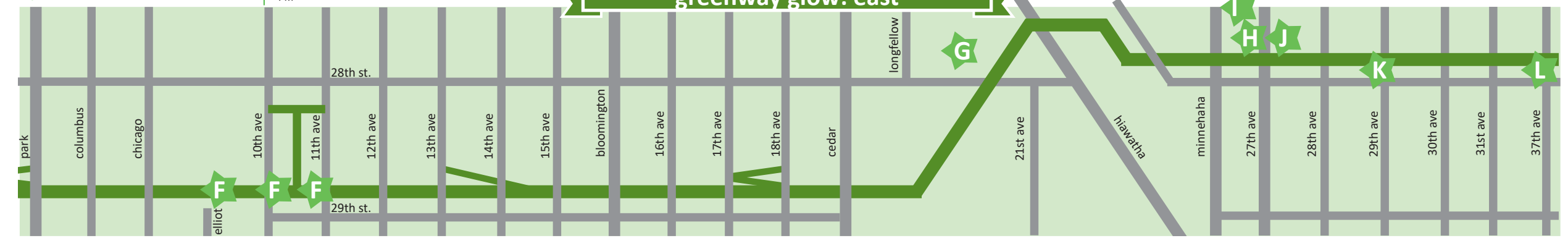
